RECONNAISSANCE ON THE PECOS, BY Mr. R. H. KERN, 1850. A military reconnaissance of the Rio Pecos, as far south as the Bosque Grande, was made, in 1850, by Mr. R. H. Kern, who was attached to the command of Captain H. B. Judd, 3d artillery. It was probably made with a compass and estimated distances, and without any astronomical observations; but of this I have no positive information. The map of the reconnaissance was used by Lieut.
